Following a successful series of the first six meetings, initially hosted in Zagreb, Croatia, under the auspices of the Croatian Cooperative Group for Hematologic Diseases (KroHem) and co-chaired by Dr. Steven Pavletic (National Cancer Institute, NIH, Bethesda, USA), the Symposium has grown into a leading international forum for advancing knowledge and collaboration in the field of cGvHD. Notably, the 7th Symposium, held in Vancouver, Canada, in 2024, marked the first meeting outside Europe and was successfully hosted by Cell Therapy Transplant Canada, with KroHem as a partner organization.

We are delighted that the 8th Symposium will return to Croatia, taking place in the historic and picturesque city of Dubrovnik, offering an inspiring setting for scientific exchange and professional networking.
